***Wall Street Journal is Winner of “Gold Keyboard” Award in the 2025 New York Press Club Journalism Awards Competition Other Top Winners are The New York Times, New York Magazine, New York Focus and Spectrum News NY1***

*The Wall Street Journal* team of Christopher Weaver, Tom McGinty, Anna Wilde Mathews, Mark Maremont, and Andrew Mollica has won the prestigious Gold Keyboard Award from the New York Press Club in the 2025 Journalism Awards Competition. The club’s signature glass statue will be presented at the Annual Awards and Installation Dinner on Monday, June 2, 7 pm aboard the Cornucopia Majesty: Pier 81 (41<sup>st</sup> Street and 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue), which will remain docked for the evening.

The Press Club’s annual Gabe Pressman Truth to Power Award will be presented to the staff of *Newsday* for bringing a lawsuit against the Office of Nassau County Executive Bruce Blakeman after he “froze out” its journalists and revoked *Newsday*’s official newspaper status following what he characterized as poor coverage of his administration. Named after Gabe Pressman, the legendary New York journalist known for his tenacious drive to present the truth and staunch support of First Amendment rights, the award honors an individual or news team whose body of work challenges the power establishment and/or defends journalists.

Prize-winning journalism included reports on the scandals at New York’s City Hall, the 2024 Presidential Campaigns, the attempted Trump Assassination, the war in Gaza and more stories from news outlets ranging from *CBS News*, *Dateline*, the *New York Post*, and *News 12*.
